

Cedarburg PAC, Inc. was founded in 1999 to help the Cedarburg School District deliver on its promise of bringing professionally managed performing artists to Ozaukee County. The Cedarburg PAC, Inc. enabled the District to fulfill its commitment to the community without assuming the financial risk of funding a Visiting Artists Series. Collaboration with the Cedarburg School District remains a vital element of the Cedarburg PAC, Inc.'s mission today. Key to this relationship is the recognized value of involving and exposing students to the performing arts/artists, as well as the operation of a performing arts center, in ways that are not otherwise possible.

Our 580-seat theatre allows audience members to get closer to their favorite vocalists, comedians, actors and musicians than many other venues. *In fact, the last row in our theatre is only 78 feet from the stage!*

With each performance an effort is made to expose students to guest artists through master classes, workshops, question & answer sessions and on-stage collaborations. In addition, we work to provide student internship experiences in conjunction with the Cedarburg PAC, Inc.'s marketing, hospitality and business functions.

BIG BAD VOODOO DADDY

Big Bad Voodoo Daddy made their debut in their hometown of Ventura, California in April of 1993 helping to usher in the swing revival founded on a colorful fusion of classic American sounds including jazz, swing, and Dixieland mixed with the energy and spirit of contemporary culture. The band has built a career through relentless touring and an impressive discography that includes the platinum selling, *Americana Deluxe* and follow-ups *This Beautiful Life*, *Save My Soul*, and *Everything You Want For Christmas*.



MIPSO

The renegade traditionalists of Mipso are doing their part to push the Appalachian folk tradition into new territory. With ringing four-part harmonies, singable yet poignant lyrics, and heart melting charisma, this North Carolina four-piece band borrows the best from bluegrass, contemporary country, pop, gospel, folk and American singer-songwriter traditions to create their hallmark sound. The group's chemistry is undeniable and their friendly banter draws audiences closer, but it's their award-winning songwriting that has earned them legions of fans.

Credited by *IndyWeek* with "expanding the vocabulary of common touchstones" for bluegrass, Mipso has become known for sly original lyrics and a distinctive sound full of soft, understated harmonies, nostalgic melodies and optimistic rhythms – harnessing the sentimental character of bluegrass and twisting in the hopeful outlook of youth.


CHERISH THE LADIES HOLIDAY PERFORMANCE

The troupe initially won recognition as the first all-women traditional music and dance ensemble, but they soon established themselves as musicians and performers without peer and have since won many thousands of fans of their music.

Cherish the Ladies has grown from a one-time concert concept to an Irish traditional music sensation and are the most successful and sought after Irish-American group in Celtic music. 

