They were truly engaged – swaying with the music, tapping their feet and singing enthusiastically. Several standing ovations near the end of the performance reinforced the students' appreciation of the performance.

Cedarburg-Grafton Rotary Club presented an evening performance of the MSO that same day. According to Layton Olsen, long-time member of Cedarburg-Grafton Rotary Club and founding sponsor and current board member of the Cedarburg PAC, Inc., "This was a wonderful arts education for the students.
